McCall is 100 miles north of Boise, Idaho.

**WHEN:** Saturday, January 27, 2018 – Gates open at 7am, practice starts at 9am, preliminary racing at 10am. Pro finals start at 2:15 after the Mardi Gras Parade downtown.

**RACER ENTRY FEES:** Pro Men \$100, Pro Women \$75, Trophy \$35, Kids \$20.

**NEAREST MAJOR AIRPORT:** Boise is 110 miles away.

**DETAILS:** This is the oldest snow bike race in the world, running every year since 2009 during the 30,000-person McCall Winter Carnival which features snow sculptures, fireworks, and always plenty of snow! Last year's event set another attendance record with 1,440 spectators and 68 racers and will run on a shorter, tighter course this year for even more thrills. Saturday's AMA National event will feature pro classes for men and women as trophy classes for racers over 40, kids, and amateur men and women.



You WILL need an AMA membership to race. You can get an annual membership at the event for \$49 or a weekend pass for \$20, or you can join online at the AMA website.
