

Fun in the Sun at the Fossil Bowl Snowbike Race

Round 4, 2021 NASBA 509/US Air Force Special Warfare National Championship Snow Bike Series, February 27 – Clarkia, Idaho

Round four of the 2021 NASBA (North American Snow Bike Association) 509/US Air Force Special Warfare National Championship Snow Bike Series featured its usual great track and (finally) enough snow to get the job done, after having to cancel the original date because of lack of snow. This was the fourth year for the event which runs on the longest, wildest course in the country (almost 2 miles) at the old school, Fossil Bowl MX facility in Northern Idaho.

Idaho riders Jake Hedlund and Canyon Ashley continued their season-long battle, with Ashley taking the win, but having to work hard for it, with Hedlund breathing down his neck all day in the men's pro class. Jamey Parks defeated long-time rival, Shayla Lillie to take the women's pro class. Jamey has been training like a dog and it is beginning to pay off.



Men's pro class winner, Canyon Ashley took another win. His recent transition from KTM to Kawasaki seems to have made him even faster.

Eternally tough, Senior, 40+ National Snowbike Champion, Jeremy Deming returned to action after missing round 4 due to a broken leg, but rivals Ryan Rogers and Jason Weis were ready for him, and Rogers took the win, with Deming second and Weis third.

Ryan's son, River Rogers had a very solid day, beating arch rival Nate Kingston in the Open Trophy class, but Kingston got him back in the always fun to watch 350 class.

The day of racing ended with the eagerly-awaited UTV (4-wheelers) taking the line, and just like last year, the crowd was treated to mayhem and the craziness that 4-wheeled racing in the snow always brings out. In the end, Jeff Conner took the win over Bryan Ross and Jesse Robinson.

At day's end, everyone agreed that this year's track continues to be one of the best in the country, and even with its remoteness and often challenges to get enough snow, it needs to keep rolling in the future.

Round 5 of the 2021 NASBA 509/Air Force Special Warfare National Championship Snow Bike Series will be held at the Driggs Snocross Track in Eastern Idaho on Sunday, March 14.
