

Cascade Steps Up To Host World's Oldest Snowbike Race

Round 2, 2022 NASBA Pure Adrenaline Motorsports National Championship Snow Bike Series, January 29 – Cascade, Idaho

Round two of the 2022 NASBA (North American Snow Bike Association) Pure Adrenaline Motorsports National Championship Snow Bike Series ran on a beautiful, $\frac{3}{4}$ mile motocross type course just off of Warm Springs Road near Cascade, and as always, it was the only motorized portion of the McCall Winter Carnival.

This is the world's oldest snow bike race; it started at the McCall Golf Course in 2009, and has been a key component of the Winter Carnival ever since, but the Covid situation changed all of that, shifting the event south to Cascade. The town of Cascade has worked hard to make the race fly; and this year's race pulled another record-sized crowd of 74 racer entries, and 1,682 spectators on a day that never got above 10F.



Boise pro Canyon Ashley recovered from some issues in the first pro men's moto, winning the second one and taking the overall win.



Unbeaten, untested Coeur 'd Alene racer, Jamey Parks, took the lead in the women's pro class and never looked back.

Numerous pieces of heavy equipment (courtesy of Granite Construction) was used to carve out two large parking lots and push that snow in the direction of the track where Valley County Recreation manager, Greg Price ran a snow grooming machine to create jumps, bumps, whoops, and banked turns. It took him two days of work, but the resulting track was a very good one.

Snowbikes are the original stars of the show, and over 40 of them turned out to wow the crowd with wild racing action, egged on by announcer Troy Hooper. Although there were plenty of crashes, snow is much more forgiving than dirt and rocks, and only one injury (a broken collarbone) was reported all day.

Snowmobiles are becoming a bigger and bigger part of the race, with classes for adults and many boys and girls under 12, most but not all of them locals, raced around and around, both on the track and off, racing, building snowmen, chasing each other and having a blast.

The day of racing ended with the eagerly-awaited UTV (4-wheelers) taking the line, and just like last year, the crowd was treated to several crazy crashes and assorted stuck machines.

Round 3 of the 2022 Pure Adrenaline Motorsports National Championship Snow Bike Series will be held at Wanoga Snow-Park, near Bend, Oregon near the Mt. Bachelor Ski Resort on February 12.
