DETAILS: Diamond Lake is a small, scenic Oregon village that sits at 5,200 feet, nine miles from Crater Lake National Park in Central Oregon. This is the ONLY snow bike race in Oregon and Washington and was last run in 2017. The race course will be slightly longer than last time with jumps, bumps and right and left hand turns. It is an excellent track for spectator viewing.
